Pay for construction industry employees in Indiana was \$57,100 in 2017, 23% more than the state average for all private-sector employees.

Gov. Eric Holcomb launched a five-year \$4.7 billion road maintenance and construction plan in 2017. The Indiana Department of Transportation plans \$810 million of work on our state's highways this year.
